Workshop by Michael Pilarski and Benjamin Pixie. Designing plantings to maximize nectar and pollen sources for honeybees and other pollinators.

The course will be applicable to both the interior and maritime Pacific Northwest and beyond.

Day one: Theory, practice, details, species selection.

Day two: Hands-on planting trees, shrubs, perennials, Building and planting a hugelkultur. Direct seeding.

Benjamin Pixie of Pixie Honey has bee yards in western Washington and at Skalitude.

Michael Pilarski, Friends of the Trees Society. Medicinal herb farmer, permaculture teacher and plant enthusiast has worked with over 1,000 species of plants.

Housing is available at Skalitude (Twisp, Eastern WA) during the workshop period.

Benjamin Pixie and a consortium of friends purchased Skalitude Retreat Center in 2018. Benjamin is a beekeeper and wants to maximize honey production at the site. Most regions of the world have their specific bee trees. Participants of this workshop will learn a template for beescaping that can inform work on all PNW sites and regions.
